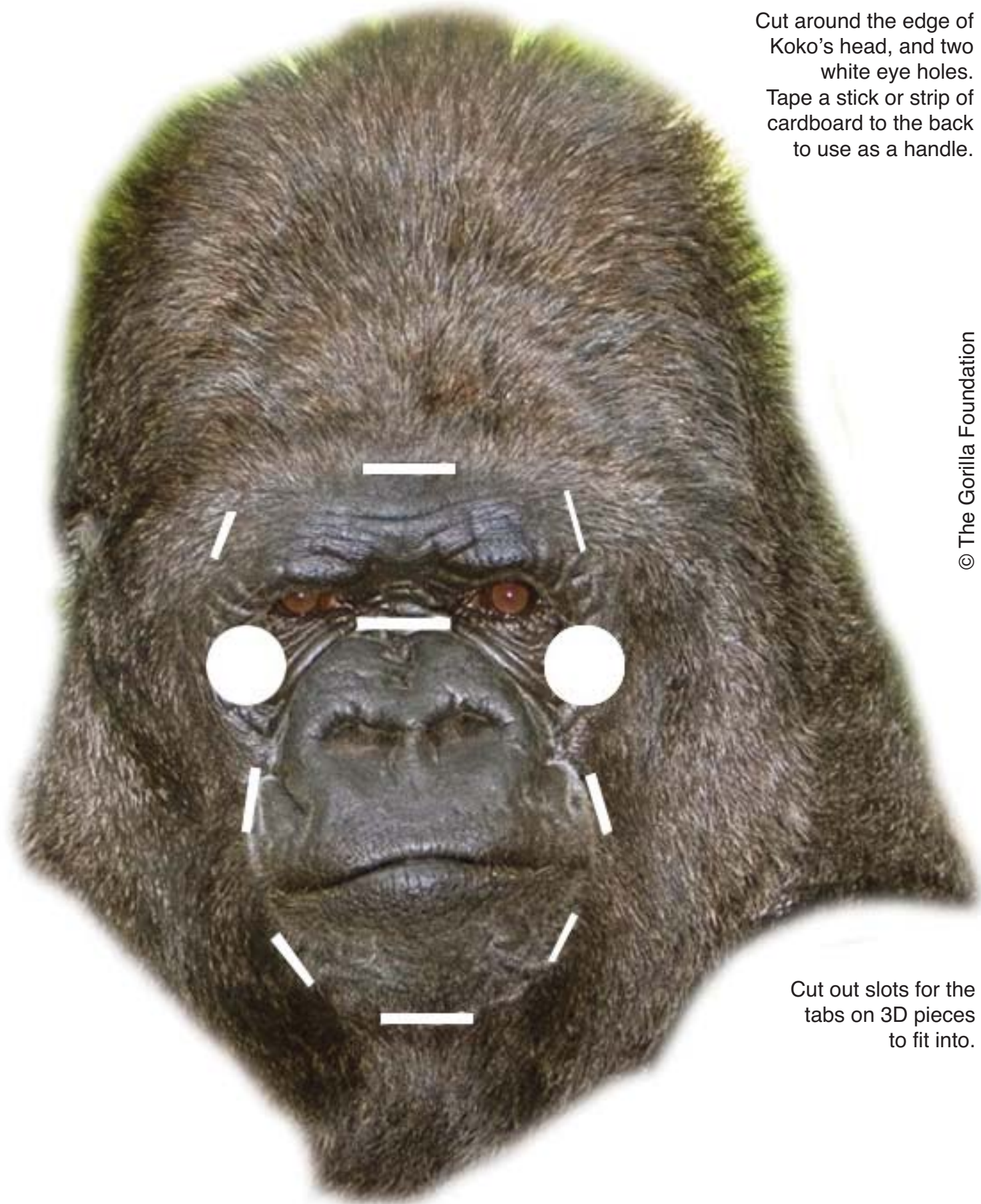


3D “eye hat”

(Koko’s name for a mask)

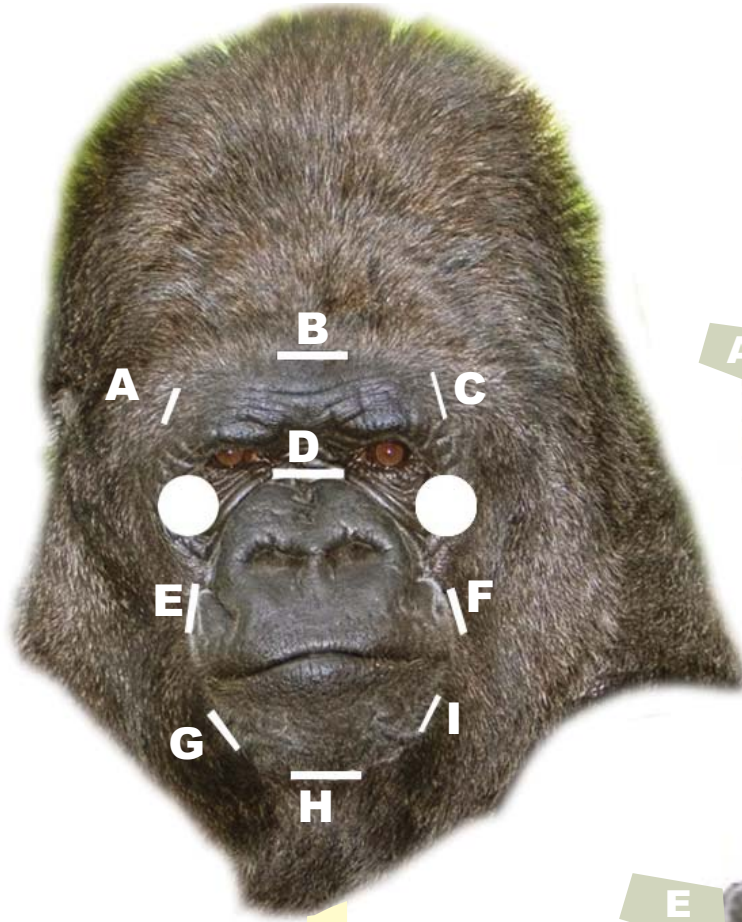
Cut around the edge of Koko’s head, and two white eye holes. Tape a stick or strip of cardboard to the back to use as a handle.

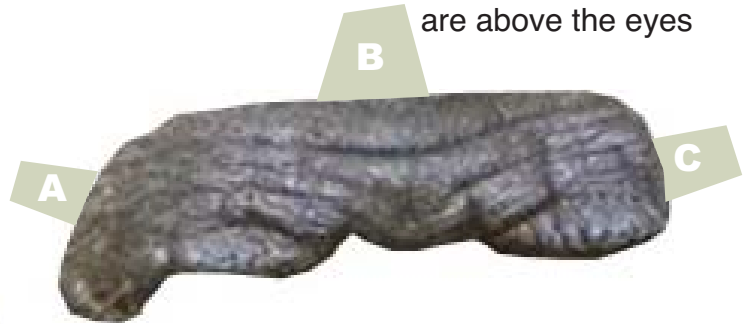
Cut out slots for the tabs on 3D pieces to fit into.

Tab placement

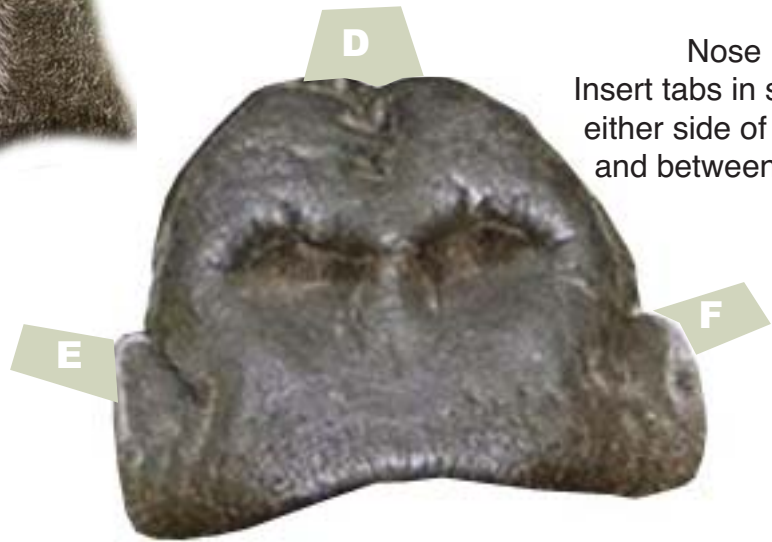


Cut around Brow, Nose and Chin and slide tabs into slots in Koko's mask as shown above. Curl the brow, nose and chin so that they stick out from surface. Hold tabs in place with tape on the back of mask.

Brow
Insert tabs in slots that are above the eyes



Nose
Insert tabs in slots on either side of mouth and between eyes



Chin
Insert tabs in slots on either side and below chin
